ADDENDUM TO CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

All conditions below must be followed by every defendant released from district, municipal, county or federal custody using a bail bond or corporate surety bond placed by a bail agent of Lehigh Valley Bail or placed by another bail agent on behalf of Lehigh Valley Bail.

1. The defendant is required to attend any and all district, municipal, county, common pleas or federal court proceedings related to the bail bond posted.
2. When the defendant is released from any jail or correctional facility, he or she is required to report to Lehigh Valley Bail within 24 hours of his or her release for a photograph.
3. If the defendant misses a court appearance, you must notify Lehigh Valley Bail and our agents will assist you.
4. The defendant is required to CHECK-IN once per week in person at the following location:

5. If it is physically impossible to CHECK-IN in person then the defendant may call 484-223-0269 to CHECK-IN by telephone once per week.
6. The defendant is required to notify Lehigh Valley Bail of all new court appearance dates. All superior court date notification must be done in person. The defendant is required to submit a copy of court date notices to Leigh Valley Bonds.
7. The defendant and indemnitor are required to notify Lehigh Valley Bail of any and all changes in address and telephone.
8. The defendant is required to notify Lehigh Valley Bail of his or her current attorney.
9. All defendants or their indemnitor must immediately notify Lehigh Valley Bail if the defendant is re-incarcerated for any reason.
10. The Defendant and indemnitor are required to pay any outstanding premium balances in accordance with the terms established in the promissory note.

Failure to comply with any above conditions of release shall be grounds to revoke the bail bond posted, re-arrest the defendant and surrender the defendant to proper authorities.

In the event of your re-arrest or surrender by Lehigh Valley Bail or any other authority, the defendant and all indemnitors shall individually be responsible for any fees or costs arising from such an arrest.

Collateral cannot be returned to the defendant or the indemnitor until the appropriate court provides written proof of discharge or exoneration of all of the bail bonds posted.
